

### MNOHS Honors Courses

Most MNOHS courses designed for students who are working *at* or *above* grade level in the core content areas offer an honors option. Elective courses with an honors option are now being developed as well. The honors option is designed by the course instructor and may include some or all of the following:

- Weekly assignments that extend standard assignments
- Weekly assignments that replace standard assignments
- Special honors projects
- Advanced topics which exceed state content standards

In some courses, these activities are identified as honors/extra credit so that students not pursuing honors credit can complete them from time to time as enrichment activities. Students who complete all the honors assignments in the course and who earn an overall grade of A or B will be given an honors designation on their transcripts.
