Hours are flexible, although all teachers are required to be online each weekday, Monday through Friday, and to hold regularly scheduled online office hours. **Some availability during MNOHS core hours (10:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m.) is preferred.**

- Complete Teaching Online, the MNOHS training course, and participate in ongoing online professional development (synchronous and asynchronous)
- Teach in a highly interactive and collaborative online environment

**Qualifications:**

- Minnesota teacher's license in physics, chemistry, and/or physical sciences for grades 9-12
- Thorough knowledge of licensure field content, resources, pedagogy, and assessment
- Excellent communication, teaching, collaboration and strategic skills
- Experience using asynchronous and synchronous communication tools and productivity software in a professional setting
- Interest in online and alternative learning environments
- Computer with high speed Internet access
- (Preferred) Experience collaborating with special education staff
- (Preferred) Experience as an online student or in online teaching
