Students and teachers are expected to be online, and actively learning and teaching, from the first day of the quarter to the last. These are called **instructional days**. There are 45 instructional days per quarter. The MNOHS Academic Success Center (ASC) is open on all instructional days. Students are also welcome to do course work on weekends, if that suits their schedules better.

Non-instructional week days include:

School holidays and breaks - Neither students or teachers are required to be active in MNOHS. Courses are open if students need or want access--except Labor Day which is before the start of the school year.

Teacher grading/prep and system upgrade days - Students are not required to be online. Courses are not accessible; academic enrichment workshops are. Teacher responsibilities depend on the individual's role at MNOHS

- Fall 8/25/21 to 11/25/21 (incoming comprehensive students + returning students in grades 9 and 10)
- Winter 1/6/22 to 2/17/22 (incoming comprehensive students)
- Spring 3/25/22 to 6/10/22 (incoming comprehensive students + students in grades 9 and 10 who tested in fall)

MCA III tests will be administered in libraries and other public sites across the state between March 15 and April 30, 2021. A list of specific dates and places will be emailed to families well in advance of this testing window.
